To find a coordinate, cut out the two L-shaped scales below.

To find a coordinate, place the scale with solid lines so that the zeros at each end of the scale are on the heavy black line on the map. Read the horizontal scale first, then the vertical scale. For example, An Khe is at BR477435. When finding a coordinate in the Z* column, place the 0 in the lower left on the solid line along the left of the column. For a coordinate in the A* column, place the 0 in the lower right on the solid line along the right

To find a coordinate, place the scale with dashed lines so that the zeros at each end of the scale are on a dashed line at a full degree (such as 13°). Read the vertical scale first, then the horizontal scale. For example, An Khe is at 13°58' N 108°39' E.
